



<u>Overview</u>

The Board of Directors for the Harris County Sports & Convention Corporation (HCSCC) has established a Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUB) program. This HCSCC policy is designed to implement a HUB program with an objective to promote development and growth of HUBs throughout Harris County by creating opportunities for minority and women owned and small businesses to compete for HCSCC contracts at NRG Park.

Policy

It is the intent of the HCSCC HUB program to promote full and equal opportunities for minority, women, and small businesses. While this program does not guarantee any right to contract with HCSCC, it does seek to actively involve HUB's in the HCSCC procurement process.

In 2009, the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts completed a study to assess disparity in procurement and contracting across all state agencies. Through a comprehensive review of the State's utilization of HUBs, the study proposed HUB aspirational goals by procurement type for future program development. HCSCC, being incorporated under the Texas Transportation Code, recognizes the HUB Goals (Exhibit 1) of this study as being narrowly tailored and incorporates the percentages as the HUB participation goals of the total value of all HCSCC expenditures greater than \$30,000.

Qualifying procurements shall include HUB participation documents (Sections A-D) that must be completed by the vendor. Vendors are required to submit all HUB documents and supporting material as part the bidding process. Failure to comply with these requirements shall cause the vendor's proposal to be rejected. A vendor may meet the requirements of the HCSCC HUB Program by fulfilling one or more of the following conditions:

- 1. Proof of HUB certified vendor status
- 2. Subcontracting to meet HCSCC Participation Goals; or
- 3. Compliance with HCSCC Good Faith Efforts

Approved certifications include:

- 1. State of Texas Historically Underutilized Business Program
- 2. City of Houston Minority and Women owned Business Enterprise (MWBE)
- 3. Houston Minority Supplier Development Council
- 4. METRO's Small Business / Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program
- 5. Women's Business Enterprise Program
- 6. Texas Department of Transportation Small Business Enterprise Program
- 7. Texas Unified Certification Program
- 8. Other certifications may be added at the discretion of HCSCC

HCSCC reserves the right to waive the HUB policy in the following instances:

- 1. Sole source procurements
- 2. Emergencies or otherwise time sensitive circumstances that directly impact scheduled events at NRG Park.
- 3. Unforeseen justifiable situations as deemed necessary and appropriate by HCSCC

Other Efforts

HCSCC also intends to increase HUB participation by doing one or more of the following as part of its procurement process:

- 1. Participate in business organizations of interest to HUB firms. Prepare and distribute information on HCSCC
- procurement procedures and opportunities that encourages HUB participation.
- 2. Direct potential vendors to online resources that include lists of certified HUBs for subcontracting.

This policy will take effect on 01 August, 2019. HCSCC will evaluate the participation goal after one year and/or at any such time an updated disparity study from Harris County or the State of Texas that is narrowly tailored becomes available to determine any modifications to the goals and/or policy requirements.
